Attendees will hear presentations on current research and will meet investigators and collaborators working in a wide range of scientific and medical fields.

The organizing committee welcomes your abstracts for oral presentations and scientific posters. All abstracts must be submitted online. no hit zone implemented at Le Bonheur

The Child Assessment and Resource Evaluation Services (CARES) team implemented a No Hit Zone at Le Bonheur. A no hit zone is an environment in which no adult shall hit another adult, no adult shall hit another child, no child shall hit another adult, and no child shall hit another child. The goal of this program is to assist in lowering the frequency of disruptive behaviors in our hospitals and clinics, promote a safe and caring atmosphere for patients, families and staff and model positive parenting at Le Bonheur.
